

NOW WITH A BETTER SYSTEM AND NEW FAMILY VIOLENCE LAWS IT'S EASIER TO SAY

ENOUGH

New laws now cover a wider range of family relationships and include all types of family violence, not just physical or sexual abuse. The new system also makes it easier for Victoria Police to act quickly and decisively to protect everyone from family violence. Families can be supported to stay in the home while the person responsible for the violence can be required to leave. Importantly these changes also make it easier for the legal system to support those in need. If you, or someone you know, are experiencing family violence it is now easier to say 'enough'.
