FAMILY VIOLENCE REGIONAL ROADSHOWS

As part of the ENOUGH campaign, roadshows are being held in a number of locations to take the ENOUGH message to every corner of Victoria and to ensure the campaign reaches local communities.

Roadshows will comprise a community information session and a sector forum.

The community information session (CIS) will highlight the unacceptability of family violence and the significance of the new laws, and is relevant to the general public. There is no need to RSVP.

The forum on the *Family Violence Protection Act 2008* will provide those working in the sector with an opportunity to learn more about the new legislation. Forums are being delivered in partnership between the Department of Justice and the Department of Human Services. Registration is required for this event.
